## Rounds

Saturday: Double WA70m/50m, 50m Barebow, 60m (Cadets Only) Sunday: WA1440 90m and 70m only

Sunday shooting will be 6 arrow ends at all distances. Compound and Recurve will shoot in individual faces at 50m and 30m

Timing of ends will be controlled by the Judges using a Chronotir Timing system.

All targets will be Layered Foam.

Sunday rounds: accompanied Juniors are welcome to shoot as Seniors. There will not be a 50+ category, entries will be changed to Senior
