Sunday : WA1440 90m, 70m, 60m only (Senior or 50+ only)

Sunday shooting will be 6 arrow ends at all distances.

Compound and Recurve will shoot in individual faces at 50m and 30m

Timing of ends will be controlled by the Judges using a Chronotir Timing system.

All targets will be Layered Foam.

Sunday rounds: accompanied Juniors are welcome to shoot as Seniors.

50+ will shoot same as Senior on Saturday, Sunday Men will be 70m, Women 60m
